Trip Registration:

- Use this registration link <https://destinationsunlimited.grcoll.co/go/oes2023>
- Select Register for this trip
 - If you already have an account look below the sign-in area and there is a place to click if you already have an account. Log-in with your email and password and pick the trip you are registering for. It asks for a code it is "oes2023"
 - If you don't have an account, you will fill in your email, create the password you would like, check the box, and click on create account. Check your email and confirm your email address by clicking the link in the email.
- Fill in your name and click **add to trip**
- If you are registering for more than one person: Add that person on the next screen and click "add to trip". Once you've added everyone you are paying for, click "**proceed to next step**"
- Click on the line of text "submit the remaining information" OR the blue box that says "add missing info"
 - Add your contact phone number, gender, date of birth and address **SAVE**
- Select the package you are purchasing **SAVE CHOICE**
- There are no add-ons offered at this time, just click **SAVE** on the bottom of the page to move to the next screen
- Select one of the Trip Protection Plans or decline
NOTE: The enhanced plan covers cancel for any reason protection at 75% which covers COVID related reasons.

- You DO NOT need to complete the medical information, just hit **SAVE** to continue to the next screen
- Sign Forms – Terms & Conditions Acknowledgement & Cancellation Policy/Trip Protection Plan Information Complete your name, the relationship to the person travelling, and your date of birth.
Select **I AGREE**.

Billing/payment Information for Commitment:

- When the registration is complete you will most likely get a message that deposits are not being accepted until there are 40 people registered. Once 40 people are registered you will receive an email to log back in and make your deposit to confirm your seat. If you opted for a trip protection plan you will pay for that at the time of deposit.
- You may however set up your billing information (credit card, debit card or an ACH transaction) and set it for auto payment should the numbers be reached.
- **You must use the online registration to take the trip protection plan. The fees we have negotiated are lower for adult travel (\$42.00 basic/\$65.00 enhanced) but must be done through the online system.**
