Now she's a tough as nails 3 year old who continues to thrive. I come back to ride each year to support cancer research and care at Smilow Cancer Hospital and Yale Cancer Center. One hundred percent of the funds we raise will go directly towards changing and saving lines. As of last year, teams are able to choose which direction funds are directed and our team is directing our donations to support Pediatric Oncology/Hematology Services Fund at the Yale's Children's Hospital.
