IMPORTANT NOTES:

What to bring: Your smile, laughter, and sense of adventure!!

Bring a Potluck dish to share. Note: There will be no refrigeration or heat source. Keep your dishes properly cold or hot - it will be approximately 1.5 hours after gathering before we eat.

Bring Place Settings. NO plates, cups, napkins, or eating utensils are provided. Bring your own beverages! No alcohol please.

Other important items to bring: Folding chair, sun screen, bug spray, binoculars if you want. Watch the weather - rain gear if needed, sun hats, sun glasses!

Wear: Sturdy shoes and comfortable clothing appropriate for the weather. Bring a light jacket.

This trip is appropriate for all ages and most levels of mobility. There will be ramps and some areas of uneven ground - *electric scooters are NOT appropriate.* Small travel wheelchairs, cane and walker friendly. This is an excellent event to bring family, friends, and potential new members!

Sample itinerary:
